- 1) **State what your investigation is about?** This is worth 0 marks, but requires an explanation

- 2) **Is your issue local, national, or global?** All three, but you are concentrating on this issue being local as it is close to home

- 3) **What action did you do? Why did you carry out this action?** PowerPoint, questionnaire, posters, leaflets, business cards. I carried this out to keep my audience entertained, to deliver this message in an interesting way

- 4) **Summarise the evidence you gathered at the research stage:** Primary and secondary (primary is face to face interview / secondary is research on the internet etc.). You need both kinds of research to make sure the facts you have are accurate and the sources are reliable.

- 5) **What was the aim of your action:** to raise awareness of your chosen topic?
