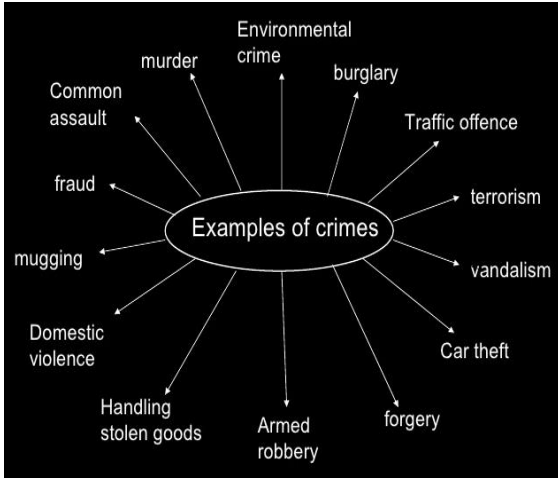


Year 7 Crime Learn Sheet

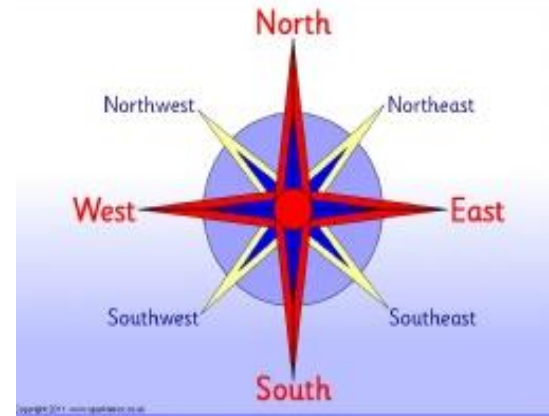
A crime is any action which breaks the law.

Effects of crime on people and the economy:

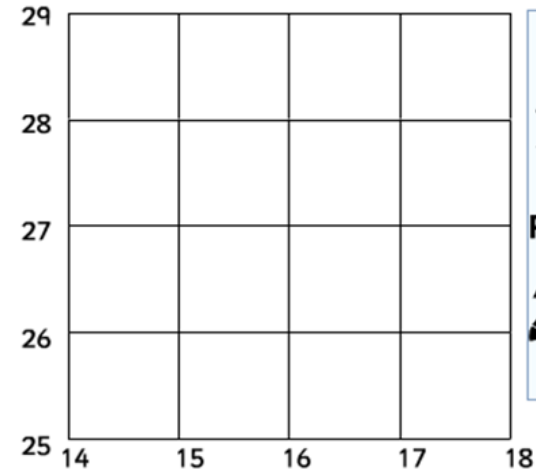
- Fear
