- A **function** relates to the intended use of a product.
- A **design brief** is a short statement which describes some or all of the following: ▲ the product to be made and its purpose; ▲ who will use it; ▲ where it will be used; ▲ where it might be sold.
- **Client:** one who pays for the services, or goods of another.  
*The lawyer met with her client to talk about their first day in court.*
- **Mosaic:** a decoration on a surface made by setting small pieces of glass, stone, or tile of different colours into another material to make patterns or pictures.



## Artist – William Morris

William Morris (24 March 1834 - 3 October 1896) was an English architect, furniture and fabric designer, artist and writer

**Modroc** (or **mod roc**) is another name for plaster impregnated bandage, and it can be used to make sculpture by very young or older **children/adults** who enjoy its versatility. In summary, **modroc** starts off dry, you then dip it in water and then model with it.



## THE 5 R'S

**Recycle** - Take an existing product that has become waste and re-process the material for use in a new product.

**Reuse** - Take an existing product that's become waste and use the material or parts for another purpose, without processing it.

**Reduce** - Minimise the amount of material and energy used during the whole of a products life cycle.

**Refuse** - Don't accept a product at all if you don't need it or if its environmentally or socially unsustainable.

**Rethink** - Our current lifestyles and the way we design and make.



**Artist - Antoni Gaudí** was born on 25 June 1852 – 10 June 1926. He was a Spanish architect who was influenced by nature, and religion. He considered every detail of his creations and integrated into his architecture such crafts as ceramics, stained glass, ironwork and carpentry.
