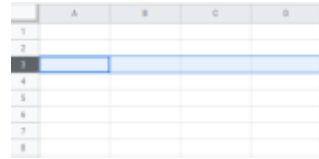

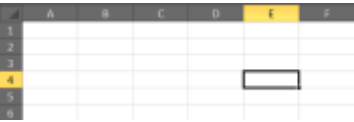
Rows: starting with a number on the left

8 tips to stay safe online

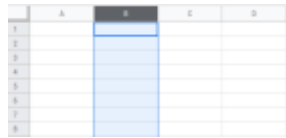
- 1 Be nice to people online.

Formulas

A formula must always start with this formula: =

Cell reference: the letter and number of a cell



Columns: starting with a letter at the top

Formatting a spreadsheet:

Tool icon	Tool name	Brief description
	Bold	Changes the text to be bold, i.e. thicker and more noticeable
	Font	Allows you to change the style/appearance of the text
	Centre align	Moves the text so that it is in the middle of the page, rather than having a margin on the left- or right-hand side of the page
	Text colour	Allows you to change the colour of the text
	Bulleted list	• Allows you to create a bullet-pointed list

Purpose of advertising

To **inform** people and **persuade** them to make a purchase.

Methods of promotion:

- Advertising:
 - Moving image – TV, YouTube
 - Audio – radio
 - Print – magazines and newspapers
 - Digital – email/social media
 - Ambient - billboards and buses



4Ps of Marketing Mix

Target market: The group of customers you aim your product at

Sexting:

Creating and sharing nudes / partially nude images.

Cyber bullying:

The repeated action of sending nasty, unwanted messages to another with the intention to cause emotional distress
