The Life of the Prophet Muhammad

Muhammad is known as the 'Seal of Prophets' which means he is the last messenger of Allah.

Born in the city of Mecca, he became an orphan at the age of 6, and was looked after by his grandfather and then his uncle.

In his early life Muhammad started off as a shepherd and then became a businessman, with people calling him Al-Amin- "The Trustworthy." At age 40, Muhammad had a visit from the Angel Jibril and became a Prophet. He spent the rest of his life preaching about Tawhid and rededicated the holy Temple (Ka'aba) back to Allah.
